



## Dress Code

ADA will offer dancewear and shoes for every style of dance we currently offer. See the receptionist for information on how to order or purchase dancewear. All students will need to purchase dancewear and shoes through the studio to ensure everyone has the same style of shoes.

### Dance With Me

- Clothing that allows comfortable movement.
- Tennis shoes or bare-feet are recommended.

### Tiny Tots and Boppers

- Pink, black, or blue leotard and pink tights. Hair pulled back away from the face in ponytail or bun.
- Black Tyette Tap shoes and pink Canvas Ballet shoes are both required for this class

### Ballet

- Black, pink or blue leotard and pink tights. Hair pulled into ponytail or bun.
- Pink ballet shoes are required (see receptionist for style needed based on student's age/level).

### Tap

- Any color leotard and tights. Jazz pants or shorts may be worn. Hair pulled back. No Jeans.
- Black tap shoes are required (see receptionist for style needed based on student's age/level).

### Jazz/Contemporary/Technique

- Any color leotard and tights. Jazz pants or shorts may be worn. Hair pulled back. No jeans.
- Tan jazz shoes are required (see receptionist for style needed based on student's age/level).

### Hip Hop

- Comfortable loose fitting clothes to allow comfortable movement. Hair pulled back.
- No jeans
- CLEAN, dry tennis shoes.

### Cheer/Poms

- Loose fitting pants or shorts and black leotard or form fitting dance top. Hair pulled back.
- CLEAN, dry tennis shoes.
